<p>Day 02</p>	<p>Haneda/Narita Airport-Imperial Palace Plaza-National Diet Building-The Tokyo tower-Asakusa Kannon Temple (Lunch/Dinner)</p> <p>Haneda/Narita Airport - Upon arrival you will meet with our representative</p> <p>Imperial Palace Plaza-The current Imperial Palace is located on the former site of Edo Castle, a large park area in Tokyo, a short walk from Tokyo Station. It is the residence of Japan's Imperial Family.*National Diet Building-The National Diet Building is the seat of the Japanese government. It houses the National Diet (480 members) and the House of Councillors (242 members). The members of the Diet are elected by the Japanese people.</p> <p>National Diet Building-The Japanese parliament is called the Diet. It consists of the House of Representatives and the House of Councillors. The members of the Diet are elected by the Japanese people.</p> <p>The Tokyo Tower- With 333 meters, Tokyo Tower is 13 meters taller than its model, the Eiffel Tower of Paris, and was completed in the year 1958 as a symbol for Japan's rebirth as a major economic power, and serves as a television and radio tower.</p> <p>Asakusa Kannon Temple - Sensōji, also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple) is a Buddhist temple located in Asakusa, Tokyo. The legend says that in the year 628, two brothers fished a statue of Kannon, the goddess of mercy, out of the Sagami River, it always returned to them. Consequently, Sensoji was built nearby for the goddess of Kannon. The temple is one of the most popular in Tokyo.</p> <p>Nakamise Arcade - Asakusa is the center of Tokyo's shitamachi (literally "low city"), one of Tokyo's districts, where the Nakamise Arcade is located. It is a very popular street market, providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional, local snacks and tourist souvenirs for centuries.</p> <p>Shinjuku- Shinjuku is one of the 23 city wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers to just the large entertainment area around Shinjuku Station.</p> <p>Shinjuku Station is the world's busiest railway station, handling more than two million passengers every day. It is on the JR Yamanote Line. Shinjuku is also one of Tokyo's major stops for long-distance highway buses and city buses.</p>
<p>Day 03</p>	<p>Tokyo-Kamakura-Hakone-Owakudani-Kawaguchiko (Breakfast/Lunch/Diner)</p> <p>Sightseeing in Kamakura</p> <p>The Great Buddha: The Great Buddha of Kamakura (Kamakura Daibutsu) is a bronze statue of Amida Buddha, 13.35 meters, it is the second tallest bronze Buddha statue in Japan, surpassed only by the statue in Nara's Todaiji Temple.</p> <p>Hakone: Hakone is part of the Fuji-Hakone-Izu National Park, less than 100 kilometers from Tokyo. Famous for its hot springs, nearby Mt. Fuji, Hakone is one of the most popular destinations among Japanese and international tourists looking for a relaxing vacation.</p> <p>Hakone Ropeway-Blessed by its wonderful natural environment, superb scenery and an abundance of natural hot springs, the Hakone Ropeway service operates at approximately one-minute intervals, and the 30-minute journey from the shore of Lake Ashi, allows visitors to take in such spectacular views as the crystal-clear blue waters of Lake Ashi and Mount Fuji on a fine, sunny day. We are sure that you will enjoy your stroll in the sky, as you find yourself surrounded by nature.</p> <p>Owakudani- Owakudani is the area around a crater created during the last eruption of Mount Hakone some 3000 years ago, where sulfurous fumes, hot springs and hot rivers can be experienced. Additionally, Owakudani has good views of Mount Fuji.</p>
	<p>Kawaguchiko-Mount Fuji-Lake Kawaguchi -Hananomiyako Flower Park-Oshino Hakkai 8 ponds-Tokyo (Breakfast/Lunch)</p> <p>Mount Fuji -Mount Fuji is with 3776 meters Japan's highest mountain. It is not surprising that the nearly perfect mountain has experienced big popularity among artists and common people throughout the centuries. Mount Fuji is an ACTIVE volcano, which most recently erupted in 1708. It stands on the border between Yamanashi and Shizuoka Prefecture. On clear days, it can be seen from Yokohama.</p>

<p>Day 04</p>	<p>Lake Kawaguchi - Lake Kawaguchiko is the most easily accessible of the Fuji Five Lakes with train and direct bus. The best views of Mount Fuji can be enjoyed from the lake's northern shores and are particularly breathtaking during the colors around the first half of November. One of the nicest spots for cherry blossoms is the seaside promenade. Enjoy the "Momiji Tunnel" for autumn colors, a maple tree covered road section along the lake's northern shore.</p> <p>Hananomiyako Flower Park- Yamanakako Hanano Miyako Koen, located at the area of Lake Yamanakako, the highest above sea level where you can enjoy various kinds of flowers from spring to autumn. "Seiryu-no-sato HOME of Spring GREENHOUSE dome, and an exhibition site of lava of Mt. Fuji.</p> <p>Oshino Hakkai 8 ponds - Oshino Hakkai is a touristy set of eight ponds in Oshino, a small village in the Fuji Five Lakes. Yamanakako on the site of a former sixth lake that dried out several hundred years ago. The eight ponds are fed down the mountain through porous layers of lava for over 80 years, resulting in very clear spring water that is renowned for its purity.</p>
<p>Day 05</p>	<p>Tokyo-Kegonno Taki Waterfall-Nikko Toshogu Shrine- Lake chuzenji- Tokyo (Breakfast/Lunch)</p> <p>KegonnoTaki Waterfall-The almost 100 meter tall Kegon Waterfall (Kegon no taki) is the most famous of Nikko Japan's three most beautiful falls, along with Nachi Waterfall in Wakayama Pref</p> <p>Nikko Toshogu Shrine-The Toshogu is the mausoleum of Tokugawa Ieyasu, founder of the Tokugawa shogunate dedicated to the spirits of Ieyasu and two other of Japan's most influential historic.</p> <p>Lake Chuzenji-Lake Chuzenji (Chuzenjiko) is a scenic lake in the mountains above the town of Nikko. It is located where an eruption blocked the valley below, thereby creating Lake Chuzenji about 20,000 Year ago.</p>
