

2-Day Tokaido Fuji Tour (1 Night at Nippondaira Hotel, Mt. Fuji Side Western-style Room) (With Dinner & Breakfast)

DAY 1

08:20-08:30

Tokyo Station Marunouchi South Exit Tokyo City i on the 1st basement floor of the KITTE building

Please meet by 8:20. The tour will depart at 8:30.

Please show your reservation confirmation sheet at reception.

Access to Tokyo City i:

Exit Tokyo Station via the Marunouchi South Exit, and look for the KITTE complex on the left. As it is easy to get lost when taking the underground route to KITTE, the street level route is recommended.

Tokyo Station (90 min)

Board a Tokaido Shinkansen (Hikari or Kodama) in the non-reserved section

10:30-

Shizuoka Station

The tour will depart from Shizuoka Station by bus for sightseeing.

Nihondaira Ropeway (5 min)

Board this 1,065-meter-long ropeway which connects the peak of Nihondaira and Kunozan Toshogu Shrine. From the ropeway window a view of Suruga Bay and, on clear days, Izu Peninsula, can be enjoyed.

Kunozan Toshogu Shrine (30 min)

A shrine dedicated to Tokugawa Ieyasu, a shogun from the Edo period. The main hall, Ishi-no-ma, and worship hall are designated National Treasures. The shrine's beautiful lacquering and carvings are a must-see.

Komagatake Ropeway (5 min) 

The ropeway will also be boarded for the return trip.

Nihondaira Ocha Kaikan (20 min) 

Tour the tea plantation here which looks out onto Mt. Fuji and Suruga Bay.

Taste testing of the Japanese tea made here is available, and tea can be purchased as well.

Shimizu (50 min)

Enjoy handmade sushi, much of which is made with fresh-caught fish from Suruga Bay.

Requests for vegetarian meals or meals without raw fish must be made at the time of reservation.

Shizuoka City Tokaido Hiroshige Museum of Art (30 min) 

Participants will be guided through this art museum in the post town of Yui-shuku, a former station along the Tokaido road which was the major route from Tokyo to Kyoto from the Edo period. The museum features ukiyo-e woodblock print art by Utagawa Hiroshige, the last ukiyo-e master.

Mt. Fuji 2nd Station (15 min) 

Enjoy the view of the mountain from Mt. Fuji's 2nd Station at an altitude of 1,500 meters.

When the Minami-Fuji Ever Green Line is closed due to ice, traffic accident or other reason, and the tour

cannot reach the 2nd Station of Mt. Fuji, the tour will visit Susono Municipal Mt. Fuji Museum, Mt. Fuji Juku-no Mori (Mt. Fuji Visitor Center Juku Forest Park), Iwamotoyama Park or other facility.

17:00 - 18:30

Mishima Station

Guide service ends at Mishima Station. Please board the Kodama Shinkansen to Atami Station in the non-reserved section.

Shizuoka Station (25 min)

A shuttle bus to the Nippondaira Hotel departs from the Shizuoka Station South Exit rotary. There are trips departing at 17:00 and 18:30.

Take time off and relax in a Nippondaira Twin room, and admire the magnificent scenery from the window.

For dinner, choose between a Japanese-style meal or Western-style meal. Please choose at the time of booking. If guests do not choose, they will be given a Western-style meal.
