Uji Bridge

Uji Bridge is thought to have been originally built sometime in the 7th century and is counted among the oldest bridges in Japan. A small protrusion off one side of the bridge known as san-no-ma offers great views.

Nakanoshima Park

Walk around this park which is built on a sandbar in the middle of the river.

The tour may be unable to drop by Nakanoshima Park in case of high water level in the Uji River, etc.

Tea Ceremony Experience at Taihoan (20 min)

Byodo-in Temple (50 min)

The temple is registered on the World Heritage List as a part of the Historic Monuments of Ancient Kyoto. An image of this temple's Phoenix Hall is featured on the 10 yen coin.
