Day 1:

Arrival Transfer by Limousine Bus (From Narita Airport)

Day 02: Tokyo Afternoon

12:15 - 13:20

Pick-up Service

Gather at designated locations (hotels in Tokyo) and board the bus bound for Hamamatsucho Bus Terminal.

13:40 -

Hamamatsucho Bus Terminal

Walk to the World Trade Center Building from Hamamatsucho Bus Terminal and visit the observation deck.

Seaside Top (observation deck) (20 min)

Enjoy a panoramic view of Tokyo's bay area from a height of 152 meters.

Imperial Palace Plaza (10 min)

Admire the view at this National Garden that was formerly a private garden of the Royal Family. Enjoy

the view of Nijubashi Bridge, which is said to be the face of the Imperial Palace, as well as the view of the Imperial Palace itself.

Ginza (drive-by)

From the window get a look at Ginza, where rows of luxury brand shops, and recently 'fast fashion' retailers, line the streets.

Senso-ji Temple & Nakamise Shopping Street (45 min)

Senso-ji, Tokyo's oldest temple, offers plenty to see including the bright red Kaminarimon Gate, a statue of the god of thunder, and a five-story pagoda. The bustling street known as "Nakamise" stretches for about 250 m from Kaminarimon Gate to Senso-ji Temple and is filled with a plethora of shops.

Sumida River Cruise (40 min)

Cruise around modern day Tokyo and experience the atmosphere of Edo.

Sumida River Cruise may be unavailable without prior notice due to river conditions. Changes in the itinerary will be provided by the guide.

As the schedule of Sumida River Cruise will be altered during cherry blossom season (expected period: mid-March – early April), arrival time may be delayed.

During the cherry blossom season (mid-March – early April), the Sumida River Cruise ride may be switched to cherry blossom viewing at Sumida Park due to congestion.

Day 03 : 1-Day Mt. Fuji & Hakone Tour (Return by Motorcoach) (No Lunch)

07:30 - 08:30

Pick-up Service

This tour can be joined from various meeting points mainly located at major hotels throughout Tokyo.

- 09:00

Hamamatsucho Bus Terminal (120 min)

Depart from Hamamatsucho and head to Mt. Fuji by bus.

(Chuo Expressway or Tomei Expressway)

Mt. Fuji 5th Station (30 min)

The bus will head up to the 5th Station along the Subaru Line. The 5th Station is situated at 2,300 meters (7,546 ft) above sea level. At this height, participants will be amazed at spectacular, breathtaking views from above the clouds.

Lunch

Lunch is not included in the tour.

Lake Ashi Cruise (15 min)

This crater lake along the southwest wall of the caldera of Mt. Hakone was formed by a powerful volcanic eruption nearly 3,000 years ago, and provides postcard views of Mt. Fuji towering 30 km northwest. Admire the superb view of Mt. Fuji from aboard a ship.

Mt. Komagatake Ropeway (50 min)

Take a 7-minute ropeway ride to the peak of Mt. Komagatake. A total of 50 minutes will be spent here, including time to walk around at the peak. Take a cableway ride up to the spiritual Hakone Shrine Mototsumiya (original shrine) that nestles at the mountaintop.

Hakone

Depart Hakone and return to Tokyo by bus.

The bus may make stops at hotels in the Hakone area and Odawara Station.

18:30 - 20:00

Shinjuku

Drop-off near Shinjuku Station West Exit

*Please head to your next destination on your own from Shinjuku.

19:00 - 20:30

Ginza

Drop-off at Sukiyabashi Intersection in Ginza.

*Please head to your next destination on your own from Ginza.

Day 04: Bullet Train (Shinkansen) from Tokyo to Osaka

Bullet (Shinkansen) just train ticket

Overnight at hotel

(Osaka Hotel)

Day 05: 1-Day Osaka Walking Tour (Round Trip from Osaka)

09:50 -

Depart from Hotel Granvia Osaka

Go to the Floating Garden Observatory on foot.

Floating Garden Observatory, Umeda District (60 min)

The open-air observatory overlooks the city of Osaka, Awaji Island and Mt. Ikoma. Enjoy panoramic views from 170 meters above the city.

An additional JPY 200 must be paid for 4 and 5 year old children for admission to the Floating Garden Observatory. (As of June 1, 2018)

Lunch at Hotel Granvia Osaka (Western-style meal) (50 min)

Vegetarian meals are available and must be requested at the time of booking.

From Higashi-Umeda Station to Temmabashi Station

The tour may use Osakajokoen Station on the way to Osaka Castle instead of Temmabashi Station.

Osaka Castle (60 min)

Osaka Castle was founded in 16th century by Hideyoshi Toyotomi, a remarkable shogun in the Sengoku period, and is known as the symbol of his power.

Board the Aqua Liner (55 min)

Enjoy seeing the seasonal scenery with a cruise along the Ogawa River aboard the Aqua Liner water bus. See a view of the famous places and historic spots of Osaka from the river.

If the Aqua Liner is out of service due to bad weather or other operational concerns, the tour will visit the Osaka Museum of History instead. If the Aqua Liner is unavailable on a Tuesday, when the Osaka Museum of History is closed, refunds will be issued by the guide on the tour day (JPY 1,700/Adult, JPY 850/Child).

Day 06: 1-Day Kyoto & Nara Tour (Round-trip from Osaka)

07:00 - 07:25

Pick-up Service

Head from pick-up hotels to Hotel Granvia Osaka

07:25 -

Hotel Granvia Osaka

Walk to Osaka Station

From Osaka Station to Kyoto Station

JR Special Rapid Service/Rapid Service (non-reserved seat) OR Bus

Depending on the number of participants, the tour will use JR train or a bus from Osaka to Kyoto, and Kintetsu train or bus from Nara to Osaka. Please note that seating is non-reserved for the trip from

Osaka to Kyoto and the trip from Nara to Osaka if using public transportation. Please note that seating is not guaranteed.

08:30 -

Depart from Sunrise Tours Desk inside Avanti (across from Kyoto Station Hachijo Exit)

All sightseeing in Kyoto and Nara on this tour is by bus. Stops will be made for pick-up at hotels along the way.

Nijo Castle (50 min)

A World Heritage site. Tour the historical castle completed in 1626, which was built to provide lodging for Tokugawa Shogun and as a palladium for Kyoto Imperial Palace. The impressive, elaborate carvings and decors in the Ninomaru Palace are a must-see.

Nijo Castle is closed on Tuesdays in January, July, August, and December. (Closed on the following day if Tuesday is a holiday.) If closed, or if the tour is during the year-end/New Year's holidays, Ryoan-ji Temple will be visited instead.

Kinkaku-ji Temple (45 min)

A World Heritage site. The wooden architecture is covered in thin layers of pure gold and is surrounded by a beautiful pond.

[Except Mondays] Kyoto Imperial Palace (40 min)

See the Kyoto Imperial Palace, which was used as the Emperor's residence until about 150 years ago.

Kyoto Imperial Palace is closed to the public on the following days. During these times, Kitano Tenmangu Shrine will be visited instead:

(Mondays, Tuesday if Monday is a national holiday, May 14-17 for the Aoi Festival, New Year's holidays, and whenever there is an Imperial Household event).

[Mondays (and Tuesdays when Monday is a national holiday)] Kitano Tenmangu Shrine (40 min)

On Mondays (and Tuesdays if a national holiday falls on the preceding Monday), this tour will visit Kitano Tenmangu Shrine instead of the Kyoto Imperial Palace. It is famous for housing the God of scholarship. This shrine's main hall is a designated national treasure. The shrine is especially great to see during the plum blossom and autumn leaf seasons.

[2018]

The tour will visit Nishi Hongan-ji Temple instead of Kitano Tenmangu Shrine on June 25, September 25 and December 25.

[2019]

The tour will visit Nishi Hongan-ji Temple instead of Kitano Tenmangu Shrine on February 25, March 25 and November 25.

Lunch (50 min)

Enjoy a Japanese/Western-style buffet for lunch. As the meal is served buffet style, vegetarian customers are also welcome.

From Kyoto to Nara (90 min)

Head to Nara via Nara Keinawa Expressway

Sightseeing at Todai-ji Temple (Great Buddha) and Nara Park (60 min)

A World Heritage site. This is the symbol of the Nara Period and one of the world's largest wooden structures. Its huge main hall and bronze Great Buddha are impressive to behold.

Kasuga Taisha Shrine (40 min)

This Nara Period shrine is designated as a World Heritage Site. The deer of Nara Park are thought to be the shrine messengers.

At Kasuga Taisha Shrine, the tour will not enter areas requiring admission.

Nara Nagomikan (20 min)

The largest souvenir shop in Nara. Enjoy yourself in this spacious shop and look for the perfect souvenir.

Nara Nagomikan may be omitted from the itinerary if it is closed on the day of the tour, or as a result of traffic congestion.

From Nara Nagomikan to Kintetsu Nara Station

Go to Kintetsu Nara Station via bus and on foot

From Kintetsu Nara Station to Osaka Namba Station

Kintetsu Rail (non-reserved seat) OR Bus

Tour ends at Osaka Namba Station

Please head to your next destination on your own after the tour.
