One of the best autumn leaf viewing spots, this area lies right at the border between Tokyo and Yamanashi Prefecture. The mountains covered in fall colors contrasted with the lake form a breathtaking panorama that's simply superb.

# Korogaki no Sato (30 min) 🕺



See numerous persimmons being hung to dry outside the village houses. Lay your eyes on a unique sight as curtains of bright orange persimmons strung like beads are hung out to dry under the sun.

The drying period for persimmons at Korogaki no Sato may vary somewhat depending on climate or weather conditions. Please note that dried persimmons will not be offered.

#### **Persimmon Picking** (40 min)

Enjoy picking persimmons (2 pieces). Reminders for Persimmon Picking:

Young children ages  $3\sim 5$  require an admission fee of JPY 400 to enter the farm. Please pay on your own, in cash upon admission to the farm. (Even if a child is 3-5 years old, if their booking was made under the child rate, the admission fee is not required.) The farm admission fee for young children ages  $0\sim2$  is free.

If fruits are not ripe for picking due to weather conditions, the tour may be cancelled. Depending on the weather, the group may be given fruits as souvenirs instead. Large bags or luggage are not allowed in the fruit picking area. 2 fruits will be picked for the fruit picking.
