

2-Day Mt. Fuji & Hakone Tour with Onsen (Hotel Kowaki-en) (Western-style Room)

07:30-08:30

Pick-up Service

This tour can be joined from various meeting points mainly located at major hotels throughout Tokyo.

09:00

Hamamatsucho Bus Terminal (150 min)

Depart from Hamamatsucho and head to Mt. Fuji by bus.

(Chuo Expressway or Tomei Expressway)

11:15-11:45

Lake Okutama Autumn Leaf Viewing (30 min)

One of the best autumn leaf viewing spots, this area lies right at the border between Tokyo and Yamanashi Prefecture. The mountains covered in fall colors contrasted with the lake form a breathtaking panorama that's simply superb.

Mt. Fuji 5th Station (30 min)

The bus will head up to the 5th Station along the Subaru Line. The 5th Station is situated at 2,300 meters (7,546 ft) above sea level. At this height, participants will be amazed at spectacular, breathtaking views from above the clouds.

Lunch (50 min)

Enjoy lunch.

Lake Ashi Cruise (15 min)

This crater lake along the southwest wall of the caldera of Mt. Hakone was formed by a powerful volcanic

eruption nearly 3,000 years ago, and provides postcard views of Mt. Fuji towering 30 km northwest. Admire the superb view of Mt. Fuji from aboard a ship.

Komagatake Ropeway (50 min) 🗼

Take a 7-minute ropeway ride to the peak of Mt. Komagatake. A total of 50 minutes will be spent here, including time to walk around at the peak. Take a cableway ride up to the spiritual Hakone Shrine Mototsumiya (original shrine) that nestles at the mountaintop.

Hakone-en

Visit Hakone-en, a garden on the shore of Lake Ashi which is home to a large 100-year-old Oshima cherry tree which blooms for all to enjoy.

Peak Viewing Season: Mid-April to early May.

Please note that the tour will not be guided to the seasonal sightseeing spots if the cherry blossoms are not at their best viewing time, or if the tour cannot proceed to Komagatake Ropeway due to road or organization circumstances.

Head to the Hotel

Depart from Hakone-en by bus or taxi and go to your hotel.

Guide service ends at this point.

Hakone Hotel Kowaki-en

Enjoy a relaxing time enveloped by the magnificent nature of Hakone at this hot spring hotel. The subtle changes of the four seasons can be seen from the open air bath which looks out onto a garden.

Meals at the hotel are not included in the booking charge.
